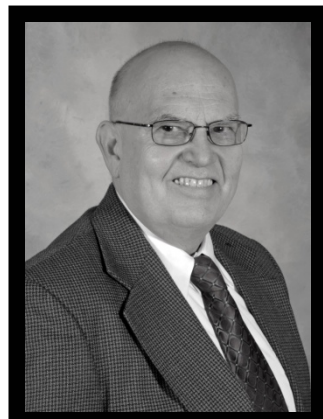
**Jonathan Cooper, D.O.**

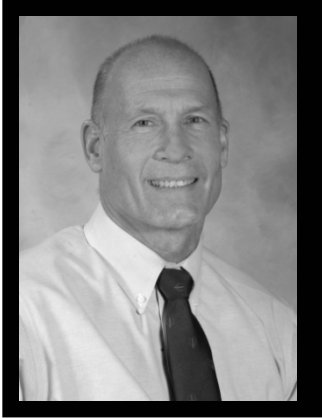
