ELIGIBILITY: Regions Hospital calculates financial assistance based on patients' household income compared to what's called the Federal Poverty Line (FPL). Patients whose household income is less than 200% of FPL will receive the most generous discount. Above 200% of FPL, the level of financial assistance will depend on household income, family size, and the total hospital charges for the care. Please refer to Regions' Financial Assistance Policy for more information. If a patient has received emergency or other medically necessary care at Regions and is eligible for financial assistance, Regions will not charge more than amounts generally billed to patients that have health insurance coverage.

HOW TO APPLY: To apply for financial assistance, patients must fill out an application form and return it to Regions by MyChart, in person, by mail or by fax using the contact information above. Patients will be asked to provide documentation verifying income (such as a federal income tax return), documents verifying liquid assets (such as savings/checking accounts, stocks, and bonds) and information about current or potential health insurance coverage (such as Medicaid, Medicare, or private insurance).
